Greetings Church:

A few weeks ago, we gathered to welcome the newest member of our church family through the service of Holy Baptism. In the process, we also revisited our own act of baptism that made us children of God and members of the body of Christ.

Every time I presider at such a ceremony, I am struck by the magnitude and power of the vows we take—the responsibility we bear to those new to our faith. Here's an excerpt from that service:

The Pastor addresses the parents/guardians of the candidates not able to answer for themselves

Pastor: In Christian love, you have presented this child/these children for Holy Baptism. Do you promise to bring (name of child) faithfully to the services of God's house, and teach them the Lord's Prayer, the Creed, and the Ten Commandments, place in their hands the Holy Scriptures and provide for their instruction in the Christian faith, that, living in the covenant of their Baptism and in communion with the Church, they may lead godly lives until the day of Jesus Christ?

Parents/Guardians respond: I do.

The pastor addresses the Sponsor(s) of those about to be baptized

Pastor: In Christian love, you have presented this child/these children for Holy Baptism. Do you promise to care faithfully for _____ and help them in every way as God gives you opportunity, that, they may bear witness of the faith we profess, and that living in the covenant of their Baptism and in communion with the Church, they may lead godly lives until the day of Jesus Christ?

Family and Sponsors respond: I do.

Following the act of baptism (washing) and anointing with oil, a lit candle is presented to the baptized or to the sponsor of a young child with the Assisting Minister sharing the following:

Assisting Minister: Let your light so shine before others that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven. **Amen**

Then comes the part of the service that involves everyone who witnessed the baptism—with a resounding welcome the following is said:

All: We welcome you into the Lord's family. We receive you as a fellow member of the body of Christ, children of the same heavenly Father, and a worker with us in the kingdom of God.

I pray that you remember your own baptismal vows and commitment to those who are a part of the family of God—members of the body of Christ known as St. James-St. Matthew's. Amen
