

The Rev. Dr. Katrina Foster was elected Bishop of the Synod during the MNYS 2025 Synod Assembly held May 2–3 in Melville, NY.

With her election, The Rev. Dr. Foster becomes the first woman to serve as Bishop of the Metropolitan New York Synod, a historic milestone in the Synod's ongoing commitment to equity and inclusion.

She has served congregations in the Bronx, Bridgehampton, and Amagansett. Now serving as pastor of St. John's Lutheran Church in Brooklyn, she brings over 30 years of ordained ministry experience, having revitalized parishes, developed senior housing and community centers, and led inclusive ministries for LGBTQIA+ individuals, immigrants, and underserved families

"I am humbled and energized by this call to serve as Bishop, and I believe God is leading us toward a future of bold faith and compassionate action," stated The Rev. Dr. Foster. "Together, we will focus on Evangelism that invites, Discipleship that transforms, and Financial Stewardship that sustains, so that our congregations become more effective Jesusfollowing, neighbor-serving communities of faith."

The Rev. Dr. Katrina Foster will officially assume office on **August 1, 2025**. The formal rite of installation is scheduled for **November 22**, following a period of transition and preparation to assume the role and responsibilities of the office of Bishop.
